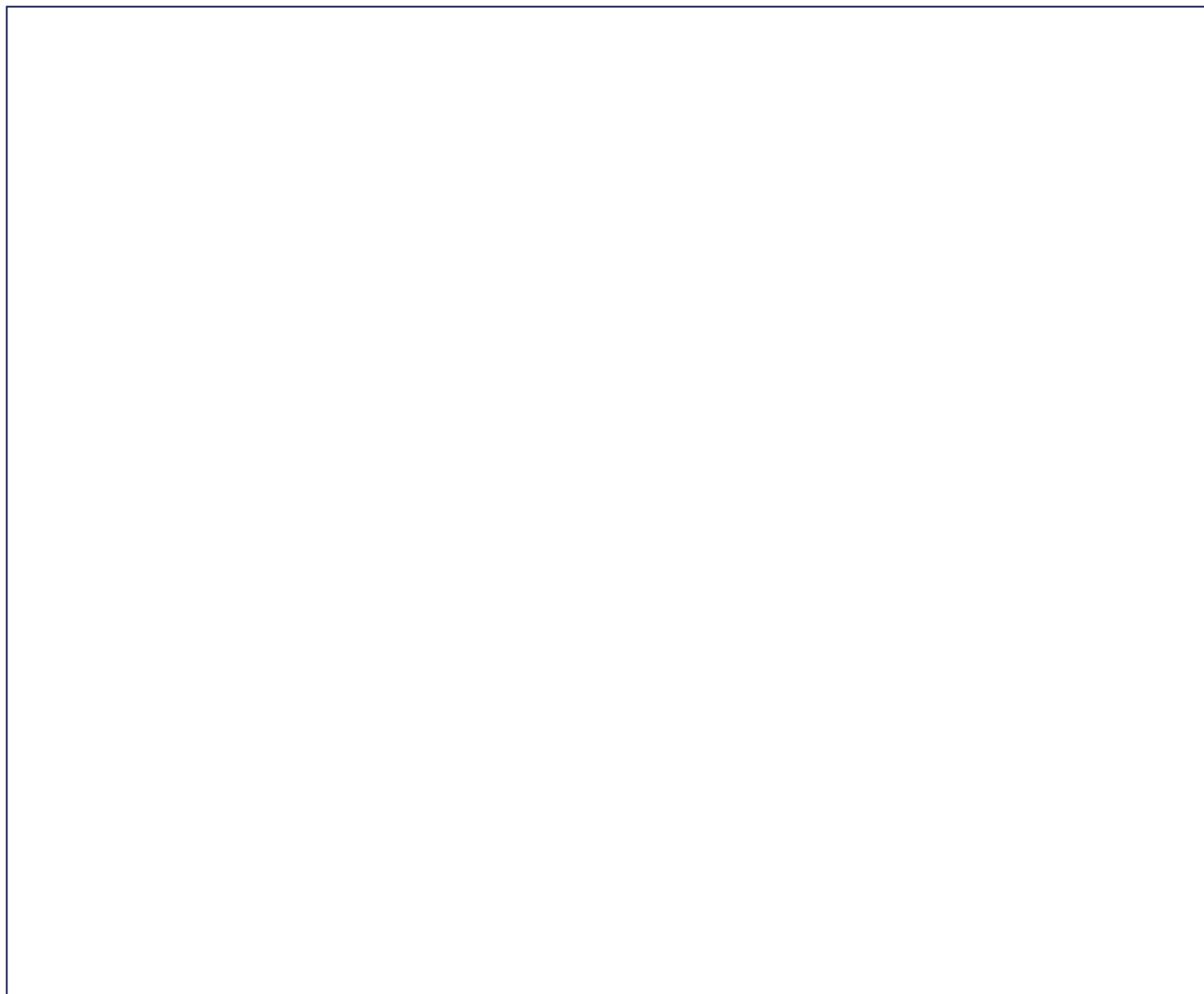


Max's Easter Egg Shop

Learning objective: To solve addition and multiplication problems involving money and use these to design an Easter display.

Max the monkey is opening an Easter shop. Help him decorate his shop window by drawing the items below. Follow the steps carefully to show the total cost of the eggs.

Draw: Draw a large shop window. Inside the window, draw 3 plain Easter eggs and 1 sparkly Easter egg. Draw a price tag next to each egg showing the correct amount (£2 for plain, £4 for sparkly). Decorate the shop window with spring flowers and patterns.



Label words: Easter egg · Price tag · Total · Pattern · Pounds · Pence

Steps:

1. Max sells one plain egg for £2. How much do 3 plain eggs cost? Write the answer here.
2. Max sells a sparkly egg for £4. Draw a price tag next to your sparkly egg in the box.
3. If you buy one plain egg (£2) and one sparkly egg (£4), what is the total cost?
4. Draw a pattern on the biggest egg in your shop.
