

## Max the Monkey's Spooky Maths Potion

Help Max solve the pumpkin patch puzzles!

- If a small pumpkin costs £2 and a bag of spooky spider webs costs £3, the total cost for both items is £5.
- If you have a £10 note and spend £7 on decorations, you will have £3 left in your change.
- To find the difference in price between a £5 pumpkin and a £2 mask, you subtract 2 from 5 to get £3.
- Max has 15 orange sweets and 12 purple sweets. To find the total number of sweets, he adds 15 and 12 to make 27.
- If you have 20p and buy a sticker for 5p, you subtract the 5p to see you have 15p remaining.

*Did you know? Did you know? A pumpkin is actually a fruit! Because they grow from flowers and have seeds inside, scientists classify them as berries. Max the Monkey thinks they are the best shape for practising maths!*
