

Max the Monkey's Spooky Maths Poster

Get ready for a spook-tacular maths adventure with Max!

- If a spooky mask costs £3 and a bag of glow-sticks costs £2, the total cost is £5. We add these numbers together to find the sum.
- To find the difference between two prices, we use subtraction. If a spider web costs £4 and a bat decoration costs £1, the difference is £3.
- When we buy 5 packets of treats at £2 each, we multiply 5 by 2 to get £10. Multiplication helps us work out the cost quickly.
- If you have a £10 note and spend £6 on party hats, you will have £4 left. This is how we calculate the change.
- Max the monkey says: Always remember to line up your digits in the correct columns when you add or subtract amounts of money!

Did you know? Did you know? In the UK, pumpkins are part of the squash family. If you have 4 pumpkins and each one costs £2, you have spent £8 altogether! Max the monkey loves using multiplication to find the total price of his spooky decorations.
