

Max the Monkey's Multiplication Market

Learning objective: To practise multiplying 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers using mental and written methods.

Max needs help at the market! Use your times tables to work out the total cost of these items. Follow these steps: 1. Read the price of one item. 2. Write the calculation. 3. Show your working out in the box. 4. Write your final answer with a £ sign.

Word bank: multiply · total · times · equals · calculation · pounds · pence · product

1. Max buys 3 bags of apples. Each bag costs £12. How much does he spend in total? Show your working out here: (2 marks)

2. Max buys 4 bunches of bananas. Each bunch costs £15. How much does he spend in total? Show your working out here: (2 marks)

3. Max buys 5 punnets of strawberries. Each punnet costs £23. How much does he spend in total? Show your working out here: (2 marks)

4. Max has £100. If he buys 6 bags of oranges at £14 each, how much money will he have left? Use this space to solve the two steps: (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Pick two items from the market and create your own multiplication word problem for a partner to solve.
