Learning objective: To round numbers to the nearest 10 and 100.

Help Max the Monkey solve these maths puzzles. If the number ends in 1, 2, 3 or 4, round down. If it ends in 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9, round up! Use the word bank to help you.

4. Max finds 48 pebbles. Round 48 to the nearest 10: (1 mark)

5. True or False: 12 rounds up to 20. (1 mark)

6. Round 765 to the nearest 100: A) 700 B) 760 C) 800* D) 900 (1 mark)

7. Max sees 36 birds. Round 36 to the nearest 10: (1 mark)

8. True or False: 81 rounded to the nearest 10 is 80. (1 mark)

9. Max has £98. Round this to the nearest £100: A) £90 B) £100* C) £110 D) £50 (1 mark)

10. Round 87 to the nearest 10: (1 mark)
