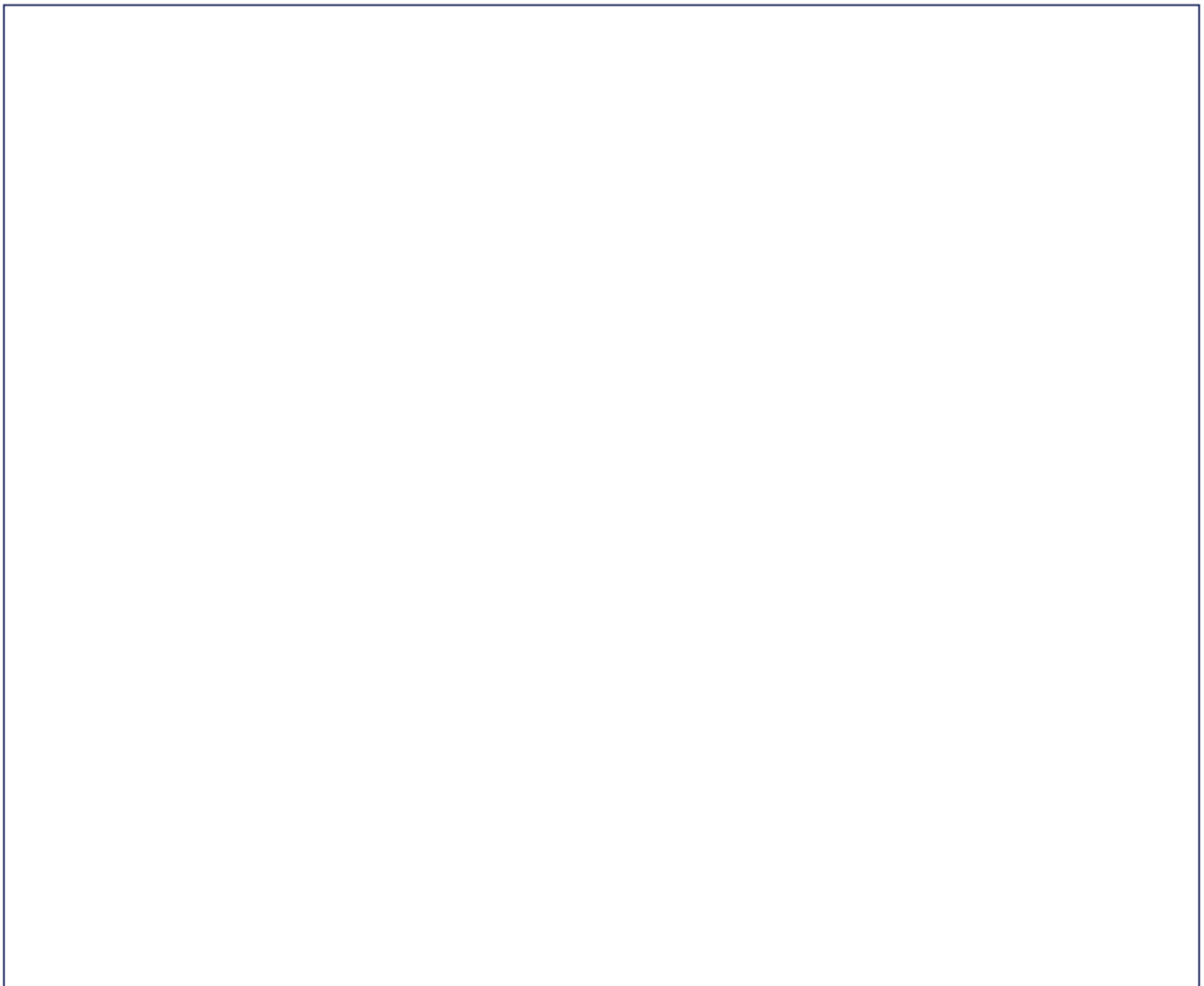


Max the Monkey's Shape Safari

Learning objective: To identify and name common 2D and 3D shapes in a real-world context.

Help Max the Monkey organise his jungle store! Look at the objects Max has found and draw them in the correct spots. Use the word bank to label your shapes.

Draw: Draw a sunny jungle scene. In the centre, draw a large square crate. On top of the crate, draw a triangular piece of cheese. To the left of the crate, draw a round ball (sphere). To the right, draw a tall, round tin (cylinder). Keep the style clean and simple, like a children's storybook illustration.



Label words: Circle · Square · Rectangle · Triangle · Cube · Sphere · Cylinder

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, square-shaped crate for Max to put his fruit in. Label the shape.
2. Step 2: Draw a round ball for Max to play with. Which 3D shape is this? Write the name below.
3. Step 3: Draw a triangular piece of cheese sitting on top of the crate. Label the shape.
4. Step 4: Max has a tin of honey that is a cylinder shape. Draw it standing next to the crate.
5. Step 5: Look at your drawing. How many sides does your square crate have? Write the number.
