

Max's Busy Day: A Time Tracking Adventure

Learning objective: To tell the time to the hour and half-past the hour, and to use language to sequence events.

Read the story about Max the monkey's day. Use the information to help you answer the questions about time. Remember to look closely at the clock faces!

Max the monkey is very busy! He wakes up at 7 o'clock. At 8 o'clock, he eats his breakfast bananas. He practises his maths puzzles at half-past 9. By 12 o'clock, it is time for lunch. In the afternoon, Max plays in the trees at half-past 2. Finally, he gets ready for bed at 7 o'clock in the evening.

Word bank: o'clock · half-past · before · after · hour hand · minute hand

1. What time does Max wake up in the morning? (1 mark)

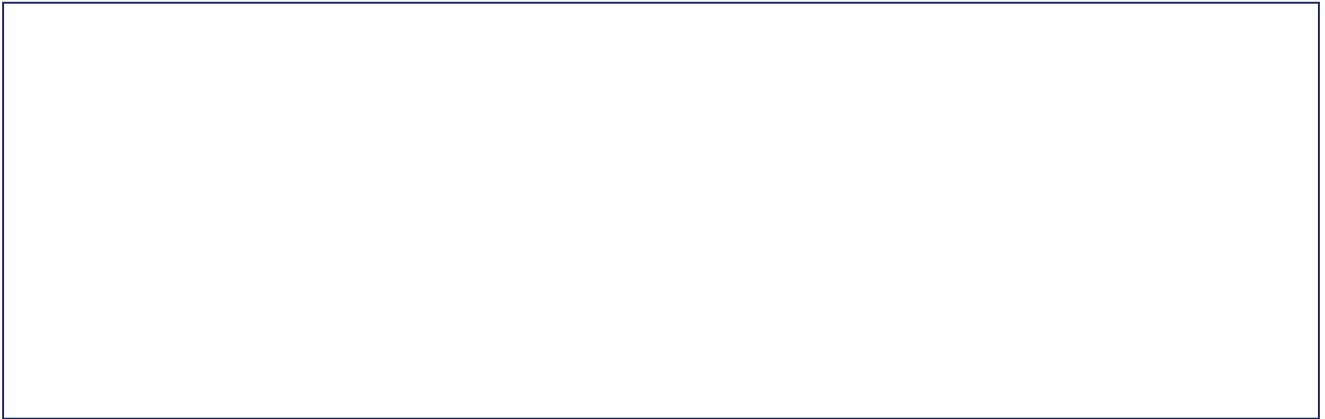
2. Max practises his maths puzzles at half-past 9. Draw where the hands would be on a clock face to show this time. (2 marks)

3. Does Max play in the trees before or after his lunch? (1 mark)

4. If Max eats his breakfast at 8 o'clock, what time does he eat his lunch? (1 mark)

5. Max goes to bed at 7 o'clock. Is this in the morning or the evening? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a clock face showing the time you usually have your dinner. Label the hour hand and the minute hand.



Extension challenge: Max wants to bake a cake. It takes 1 hour to bake. If he puts the cake in the oven at 3 o'clock, what time will it be ready?
