

Max the Monkey's Times Table Garden

Learning objective: To practise and recall multiplication facts for the 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 times tables.

Max the Monkey is planting flowers in his garden. Each flowerpot has a multiplication sum on it. Draw a line to match each flowerpot to the correct answer on the flower petals. Use the multiplication square to help you if you get stuck.

Word bank: multiply · product · times table · equal · total

1. Match the sum: $6 \times 4 = \underline{\quad}$ (1 mark)

2. Match the sum: $7 \times 3 = \underline{\quad}$ (1 mark)

3. Match the sum: $9 \times 5 = \underline{\quad}$ (1 mark)

4. Match the sum: $12 \times 2 = \underline{\quad}$ (1 mark)

5. Max has 8 rows of flowers with 6 flowers in each row. How many flowers are there in total? Show your working out. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a happy monkey holding a basket of flowers, with the answer to 11×3 written on the basket.



Extension challenge: Can you write your own times table challenge for Max to solve? Try using a number greater than 10!
