

Max's Times Table Treasure Hunt

Learning objective: To practise and recall multiplication facts for the 3, 6, and 9 times tables.

Hello! I am Max the monkey. I love solving maths puzzles! Use your times table skills to help me count my fruit. Read the questions below and fill in the boxes.

Max has been busy gathering snacks for his friends. He has 4 baskets. Each basket has 3 bananas inside. He also has 6 plates. Each plate has 6 berries. Max uses his times tables to count them quickly!

Word bank: multiply · product · times · equals · groups

1. Max has 4 baskets. Each has 3 bananas. How many bananas are there in total? ($4 \times 3 = ?$) (2 marks)

2. Max has 6 plates. Each has 6 berries. How many berries are there in total? ($6 \times 6 = ?$) (2 marks)

3. If Max has 9 bags and each bag has 2 apples, how many apples does he have? ($9 \times 2 = ?$) (2 marks)

4. Max finds 3 piles of nuts. Each pile has 9 nuts. How many nuts are there? ($3 \times 9 = ?$) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw 3 baskets and put 9 apples in each basket. How many apples did you draw in total?



Extension challenge: Max has £5. He wants to buy 7 stickers. Each sticker costs £1. Does he have enough money? Explain why.
