

## Celebrating Heroes: A Drawing Activity

*Learning objective: To recognise the contributions of inspirational Black figures and express appreciation through creative drawing.*

Follow the steps below to create your tribute picture. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. Think about what makes a person a hero while you draw.

**Draw:** Draw a large, clear portrait of an inspirational person in the middle of the page. Use bright colours. Around the person, draw symbols that represent their work, such as a dove for peace, a globe for travel, or a pen for writing. Keep the style simple and bold so labels can be added easily.



*Label words: Hero · Kindness · Courage · Change · Inspiration · Community*

### Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a person you think is a hero in the centre of the box. What are they wearing?
2. Step 2: Draw something in the background that shows what this person did to help others (e.g., a book, a garden, or a medal).
3. Step 3: Choose two words from the word bank to label your drawing.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence to say why you chose this person.
