

Celebrating Amazing People with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To understand that everyone has a unique story and to recognise the contributions of inspirational Black historical figures.

Read the questions with an adult and use your best handwriting to answer. Think about how we can be kind and celebrate the differences that make us all special.

Ellie the Elephant has an incredible memory! She loves to remember the stories of people from the past who worked hard to make the world a fairer and kinder place for everyone. Black History Month is a special time when we learn about these amazing people, listen to their stories, and celebrate all the wonderful things they have done.

1. Ellie loves to remember stories from the past. Why is it important to learn about people who have helped others? (2 marks)

2. Can you name one way you can show kindness to a friend at school today? (2 marks)

3. Black History Month is a time to celebrate. How do you feel when you learn about someone who did something brave? (1 mark)

4. If you could do one big thing to help your community, what would it be? (2 marks)

5. Look at the word bank. Which word describes someone who stands up for what is right? Write it here. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a person you think is a hero. It could be someone famous from history, a family member, or a friend who is always kind to you.



Extension challenge: Ask an adult to help you find a book about someone who changed the world. Tell your class one new thing you learned about them tomorrow morning!
