

My Friendship Garden

Learning objective: To understand the qualities that make a good friend and how to show kindness.

Follow the steps below to draw your Friendship Garden. Use the word bank to help you label the things that make a friendship grow.

Draw: Create a colourful scene of a garden. Include a bright sun, two friends (you can draw yourself and a friend), and beautiful flowers. Use bright colours and clear labels for your drawings. The style should be happy and welcoming.



Label words: Kindness · Sharing · Listening · Trust · Support · Fun

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, bright sun in the corner of your page. Label it with the word 'Kindness' to show how it warms up a friendship.
2. Step 2: Draw two friends playing together in the middle of the garden. What are they doing? Write one sentence about it below.
3. Step 3: Draw three flowers. Label each flower with a quality that helps a friendship grow, using words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a path leading to your friends. Label the path 'Support' to show how friends help each other.
