

Kindness Advent Assessment

Learning objective: To understand how small acts of kindness help others and build a positive community.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help with spelling. Answer in full sentences where possible.

Max the monkey is making a Kindness Advent calendar for his friends. Every day in December, he does something helpful. He shares his snacks, helps clean the classroom, and tells his friends why he likes them. Pip the caterpillar notices that when Max is kind, everyone else feels happier too.

1. Why is it important to show kindness to others? Give one reason. (2 marks)

2. Max shares his snacks with a friend. Is this an example of kindness? Why? (2 marks)

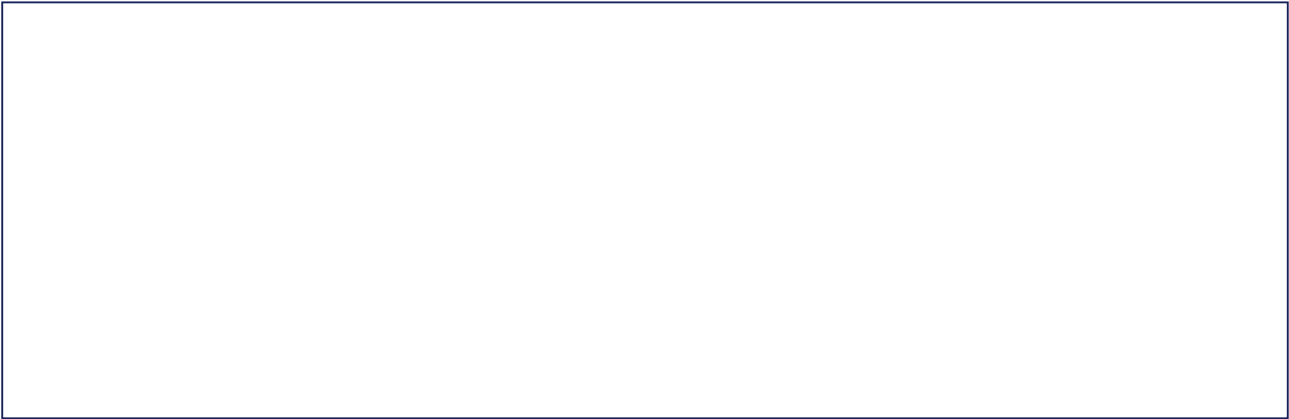
3. List two kind things you could do for a friend in your classroom. (4 marks)

4. If someone is feeling sad, how can your words or actions help them feel better? (4 marks)

5. Think of a time you were kind to someone, or someone was kind to you. Describe what happened and how it made you feel. (8 marks)

6. Why do you think being kind helps our whole school community? (5 marks)
