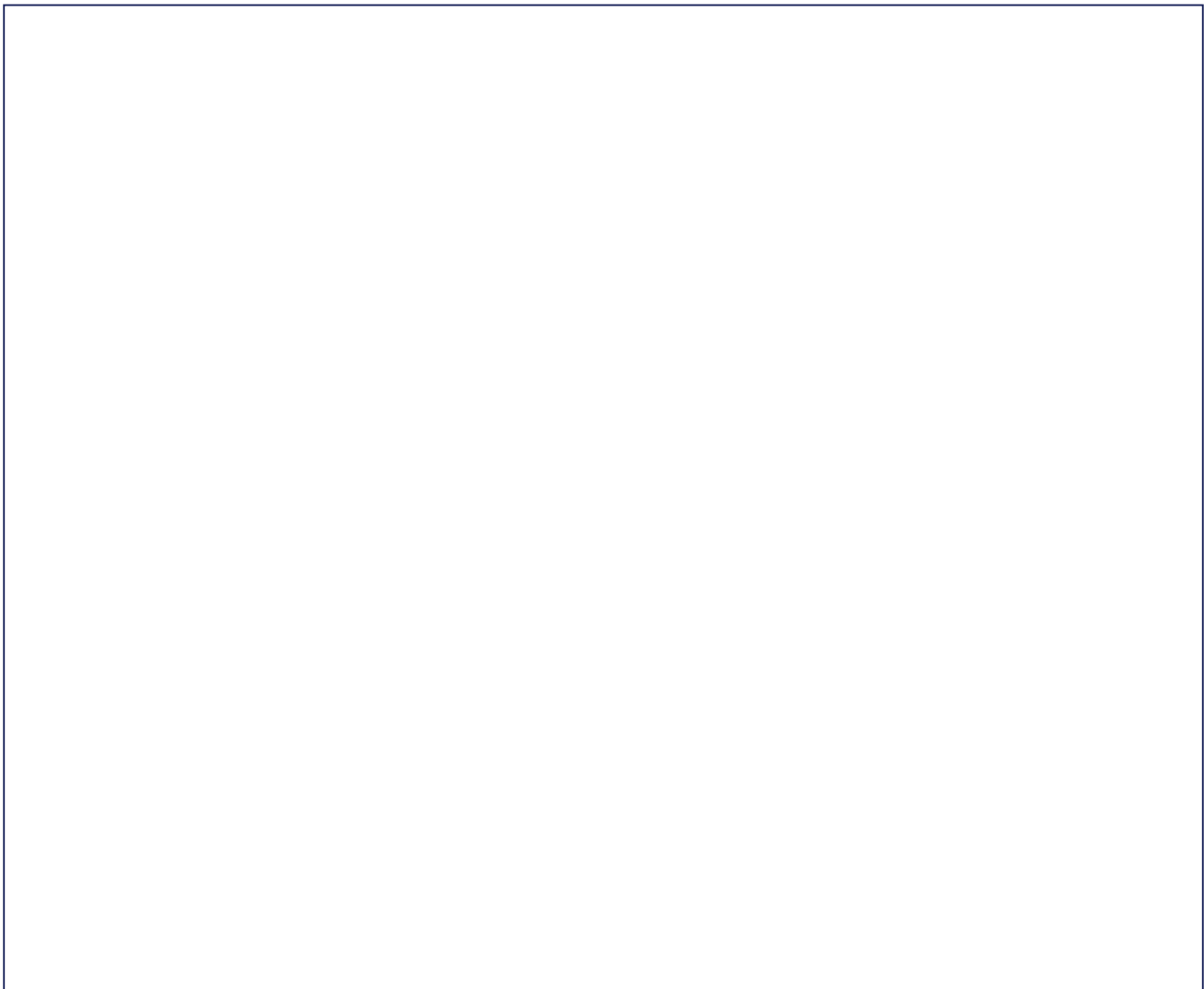


Kit's Clever Computing Rules

Learning objective: To understand how to stay safe and ask for help when using tablets or computers.

Look at the drawing prompt below. Use your pencils and crayons to create a picture of a safe digital space. Then, answer the questions to show what you know about using technology safely.

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself sitting in a comfortable chair using a tablet. Next to you, draw Kit the fox helping you choose a fun, safe game. Make sure to include a bright screen, a window showing the sunny outdoors, and your trusted adult nearby. Use bright colours and make the scene look happy and calm.
