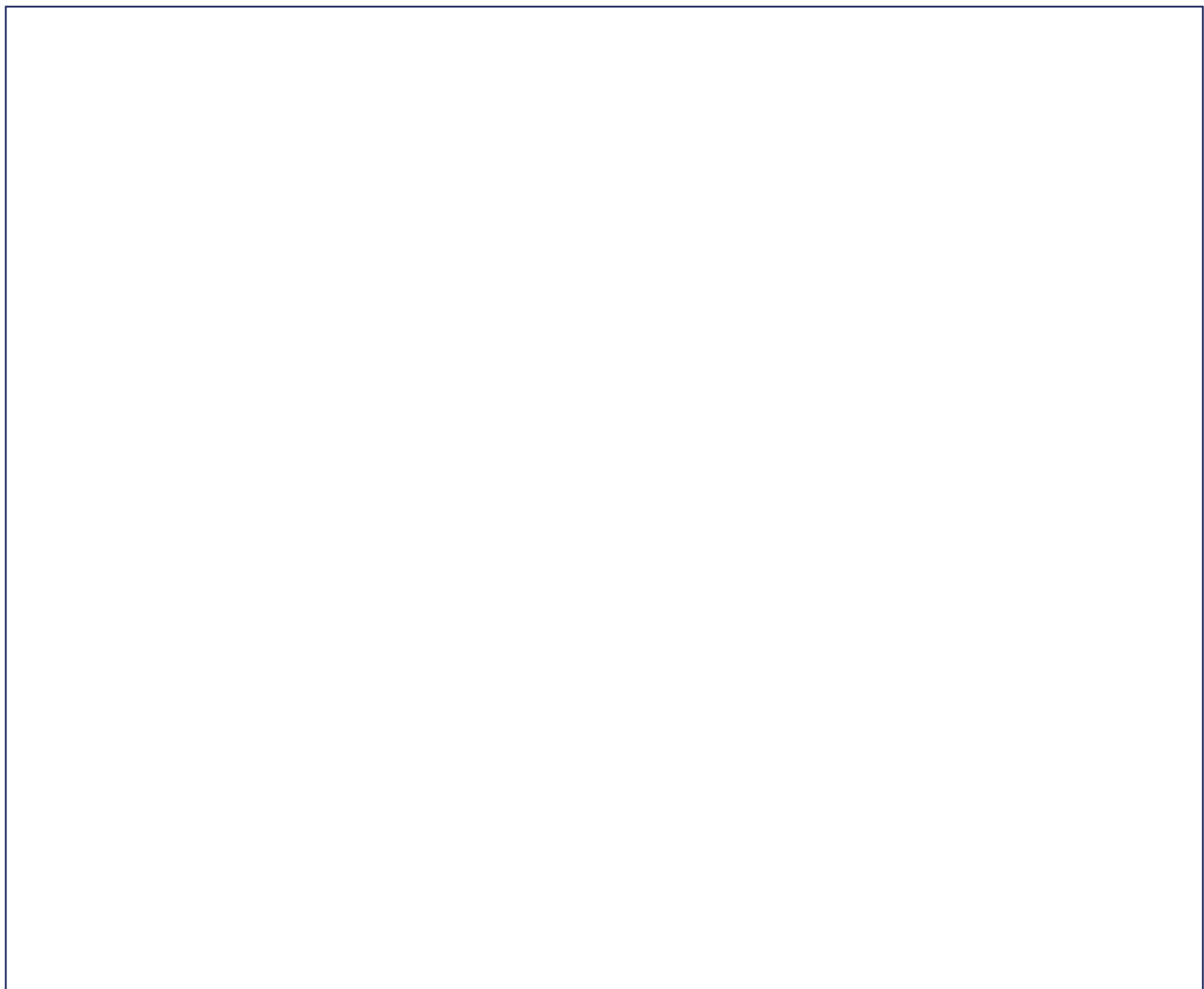


Keeping Safe with Kit

Learning objective: To identify trusted adults and safe places in our community.

Look at the drawing prompt. Follow the steps below to complete your safety scene. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

Draw: Draw a bright, colourful scene in a park or on a high street. Include Kit the fox, yourself, and a trusted adult. The style should be clear and friendly, like a cartoon. Include a building in the background that represents a safe place (like a school, a library, or a police station). Add speech bubbles showing you and Kit asking for help or saying hello to the trusted adult.



Label words: Trusted Adult · Safe Place · Help · Emergency · Friend

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw yourself and Kit the fox standing in a safe place. Who is the trusted adult with you? Draw them next to you.
2. Step 2: Label your trusted adult. Why do you trust them? Write one short sentence.
3. Step 3: Draw a sign in your picture that shows where to go for help, like a shop or a school.
4. Step 4: Think of one person you can talk to if you feel worried. Write their name here.
