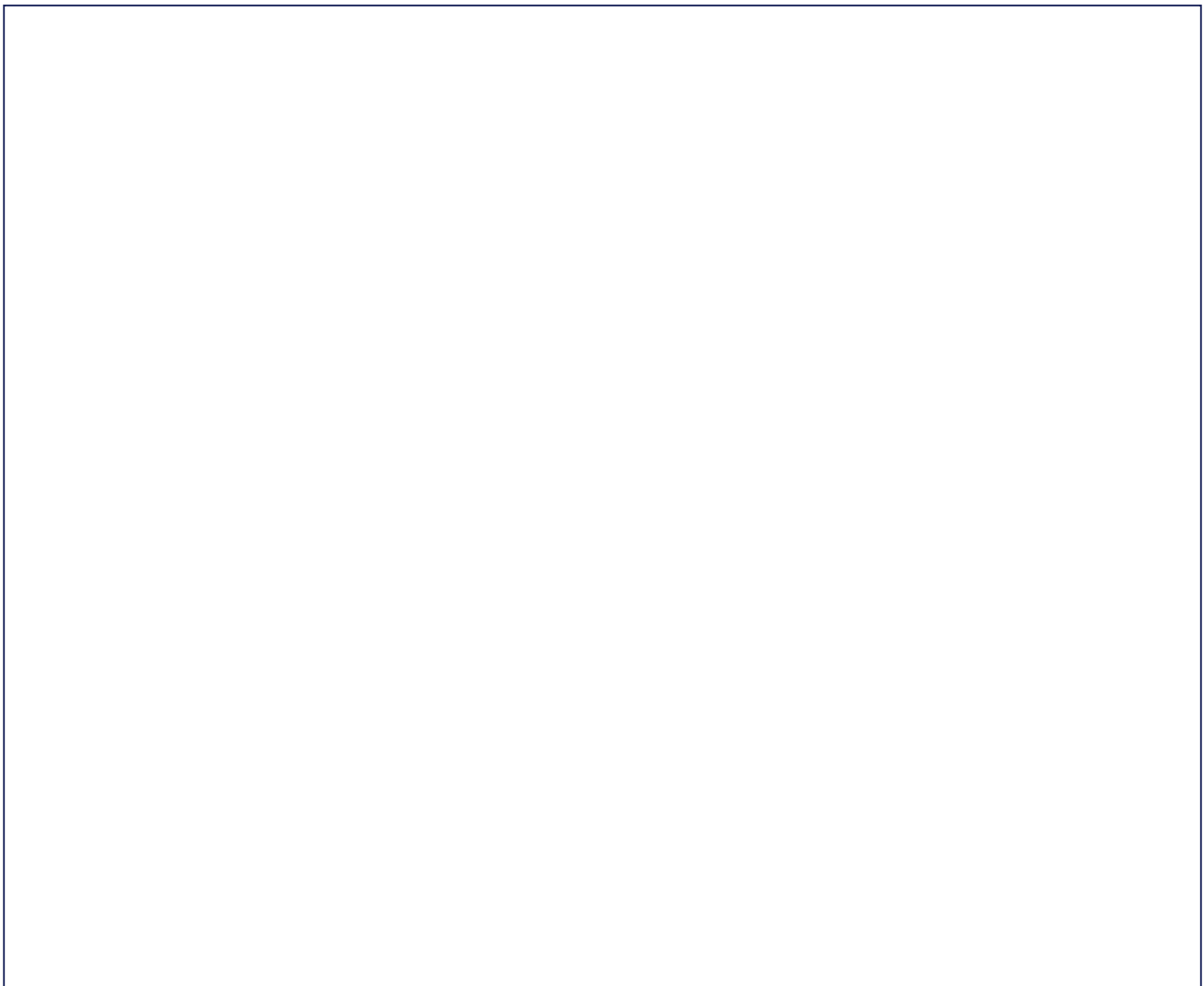


My Kind Friends and Me

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate positive relationships and acts of kindness within the school or home environment.

Today, we are thinking about our friends! Use the space below to draw a special moment you share with someone you care about. Think about what makes a good friend, such as sharing, listening, or playing games together.

Draw: A landscape-oriented box for a child to draw a scene of them playing with a friend. Style should be open and inviting. The scene should include two figures interacting positively (e.g., sharing a toy or holding hands). Include space for a speech bubble and labels using the provided word bank.



Label words: Kind · Share · Smile · Friend · Listen · Happy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw yourself and your friend in the box below. What are you doing together?
2. Step 2: Add a speech bubble to your drawing. What kind thing are you saying to your friend?
3. Step 3: Label your friend using a word from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a sun or a heart in the corner to show how your friend makes you feel.
5. Step 5: Write or copy one thing you love to share with your friends.
