

Exploring Christian Symbols with Pip

Learning objective: To identify and understand the meaning of key symbols used in Christianity.

Pip the caterpillar is learning about symbols that Christians use to show their faith. Follow the steps below to draw your own symbols. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a scene that includes a large wooden cross as the main focus. Below the cross, draw a simple fish shape. To the left, draw a tall candle with a golden flame. Above the cross, draw a peaceful dove with wings spread. Use bright colours to make your symbols stand out clearly.



Label words: Cross · Dove · Fish · Candle · Light

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large cross in the centre of your page. Why is the cross an important symbol for Christians?
2. Step 2: Draw a small fish near the bottom of your page. Label the fish using the word bank.
3. Step 3: Draw a candle with a bright flame. What do you think the light of the candle stands for?
4. Step 4: Draw a dove flying above your cross. Label the dove using the word bank.
