

Creation Stories: Assessment

Learning objective: To show understanding of creation stories from different religious traditions.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell tricky words. Write your answers on the lines provided.

People around the world have different stories about how the world began. These are called creation stories. Some stories say the world was made by a creator. Other stories talk about the world growing from nature. These stories are special to many people and help them understand their beliefs.

1. What is the name we give to stories that explain how the world began? (1 mark) (1 mark)

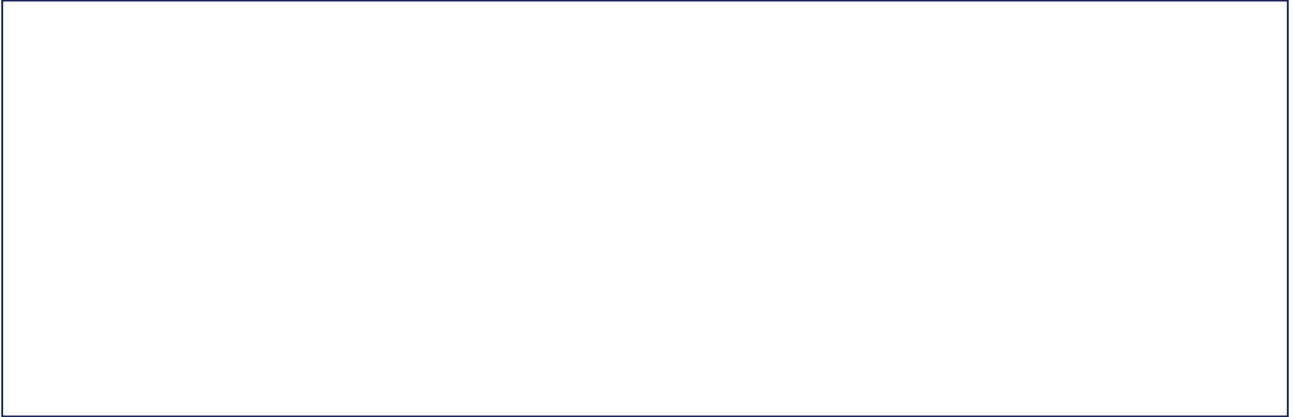
2. Name two things that might be created in a creation story (e.g., plants or animals). (2 marks) (2 marks)
