Learning objective: To think about right and wrong choices and understand how our actions affect others.

Hello! I am Max the monkey. I love solving puzzles, but some choices are tricky to solve. Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your answers. You can do it!

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.True, 3.False, 4.True, 5.Honesty, 6.B, 7.True, 8.Sharing, 9.A, 10.Apologise. Moral questions help us decide what is the right thing to do in a tricky situation.

4. True or False: Fairness means treating everyone in the same way. (1 mark)

5. If you break a toy by accident, which word describes telling the owner what happened? (Hint: Starts with H) (1 mark)

6. What should you do if you see someone feeling lonely? A) Ignore them, B) Invite them to play*, C) Laugh at them, D) Run away (1 mark)

7. True or False: Being kind makes other people feel happy. (1 mark)

8. If you have two apples and your friend has none, what moral action should you take? (Hint: Starts with S) (1 mark)

9. What is a 'moral' question? A) A question about right and wrong*, B) A maths sum, C) A question about the weather, D) A list of favourite colours (1 mark)

10. If you hurt someone's feelings, what is the best thing to do? (Hint: Starts with A) (1 mark)
