Learning objective: To identify key features of places of worship and explain why they are important to believers.

Church ——— Holy Book

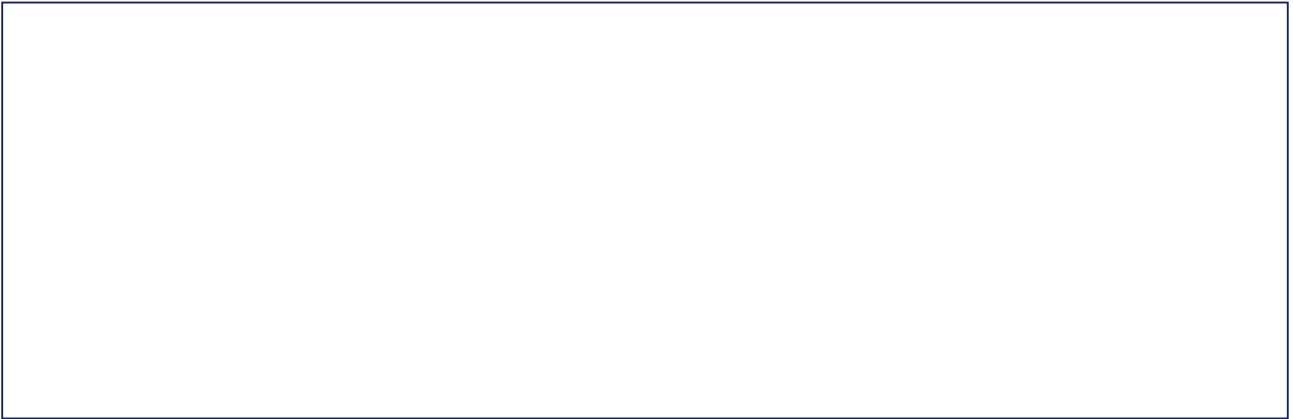
Mosque ——— Prayer Mat
