

Ways We Talk and Think: A Prayer Activity with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand that prayer is a way for religious believers to communicate with God, and to recognise that people pray in many different ways.

Leo the Lion is learning about how different people pray. Look at the list of actions below. Decide if each action is a way that someone might pray or show thanks, and write 'Yes' or 'No' in the box. Then, use the sentence starters to explain why people choose to pray.
