

Learning about the Gurdwara

Learning objective: To identify and label key features of a Sikh place of worship, the Gurdwara.

Follow the steps below to complete your drawing of a Gurdwara. Use the word bank to help you label the important parts of the building.

Draw: Draw a large, welcoming building. Place a dome on the roof. Draw a tall flag pole with a triangular flag outside the front door. Add a small shelf or area near the door for shoes. Inside the building, draw a large open room for sitting on the floor to pray. Use bright, happy colours to show that the Gurdwara is a place of peace.



Label words: Nishan Sahib · Dome · Langar Hall · Shoe Rack · Prayer Hall

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large building with a rounded roof called a dome. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw a tall flag pole outside the building. This is the Nishan Sahib. Label it.
3. Step 3: Draw a small area near the entrance for shoes. Label this as the 'Shoe Rack'.
4. Step 4: Why is it important to take shoes off before entering the prayer hall?
