Learning objective: To observe and describe how living things change during the season of autumn.

Follow the prompts below to write about your observations of nature. Use the word bank to help you write full sentences.

As the season changes to autumn, Nova the owl notices that the woods are starting to look very different.

1. What happens to the leaves on the trees in autumn? Start your sentence with: In autumn, the leaves... (2 marks)

2. How does the air feel outside during the autumn months? Start your sentence with: The temperature feels... (2 marks)

3. Why do you think the leaves change colour? Start your sentence with: The leaves change colour because... (2 marks)

4. What do you see on the ground under the trees? Start your sentence with: On the ground, I can see... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you draw a picture of a tree in autumn and label the colours you can see?
