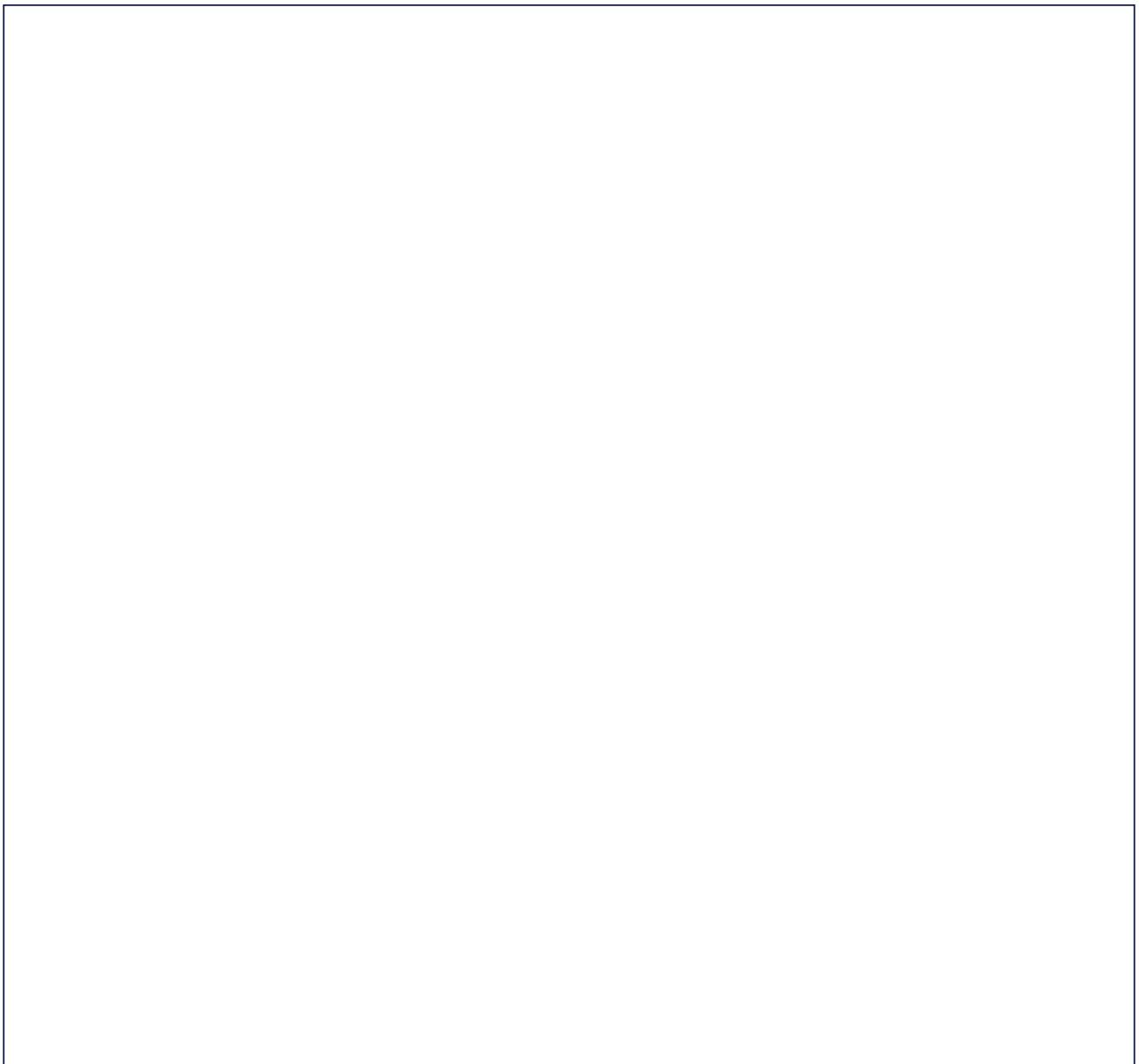


Bea's Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and name the basic parts of a flowering plant.

Read the fun facts with an adult, then colour in the picture. Use your best colouring pencils to make the plant look bright and healthy. Once you have finished, use the labels to show where the different parts of the plant are.

Colour this: A large, friendly illustration of a sunflower in the centre of the page. The sunflower has a large circular head with petals, a tall, thick stem with two wide leaves branching off, and visible roots at the bottom under the soil line. Bea the honeybee is drawn flying next to the flower with a happy smile. The background is simple, featuring a bright sun in the corner and a few fluffy clouds, leaving plenty of white space for the child to colour.
