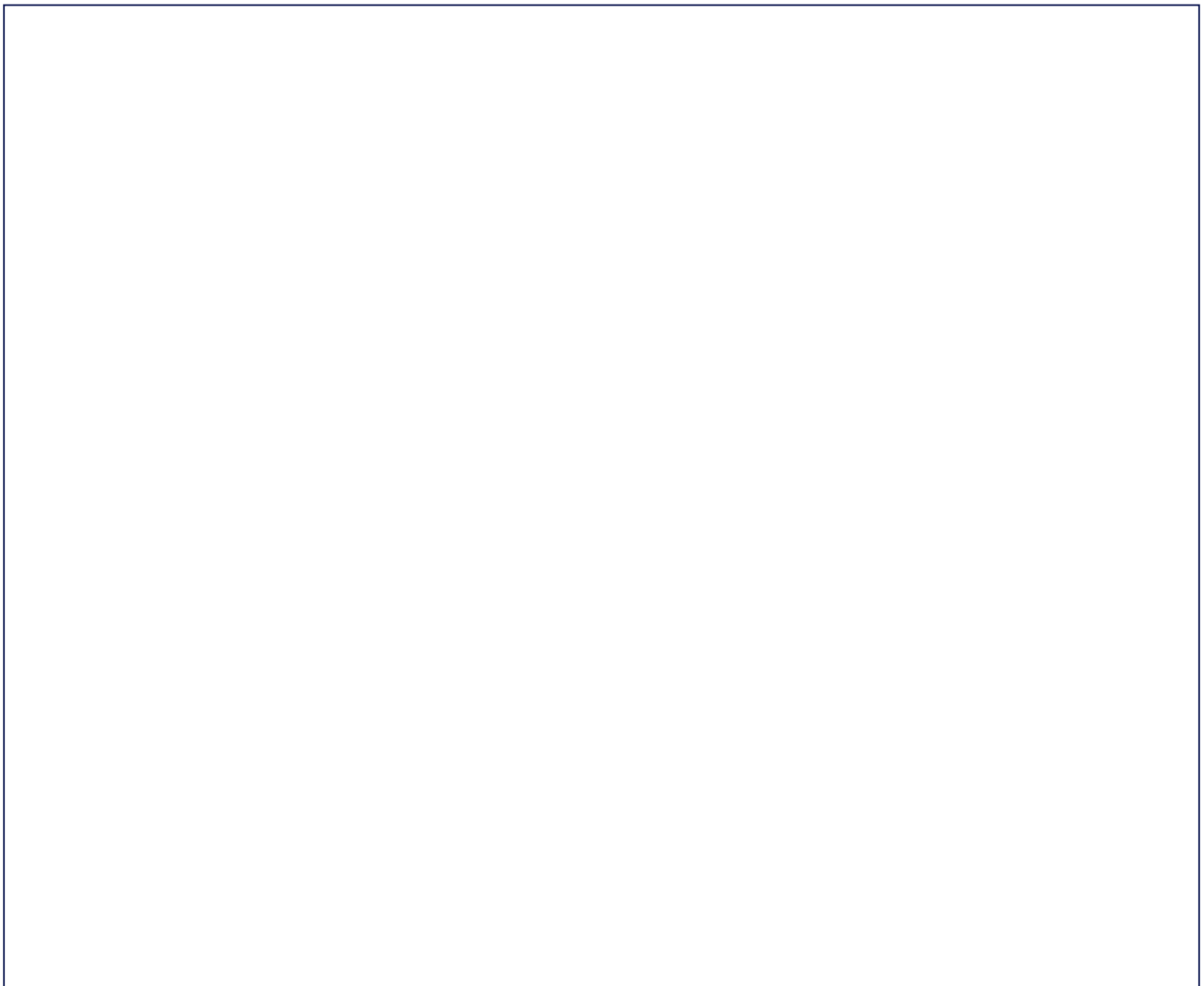


Bea the Bee's Plant Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and label the main parts of a flowering plant.

Follow the steps below to draw your own plant. Use the labels from the word bank to name each part. You can colour your plant when you are finished!

Draw: Draw a clear, simple scientific diagram of a flowering plant. Include roots underground, a stem above ground, leaves attached to the stem, and a flower at the top. Use pencil for the outline and bright colours for the flower and leaves. Leave space next to each part for a label.



Label words: roots · stem · leaves · flower

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a plant in the space below. Start by drawing the roots at the bottom.
2. Step 2: Draw a tall, straight stem coming up from the roots.
3. Step 3: Draw two green leaves on the stem.
4. Step 4: Draw a bright flower at the very top of your stem.
5. Step 5: Label your drawing using the words in the word bank.
