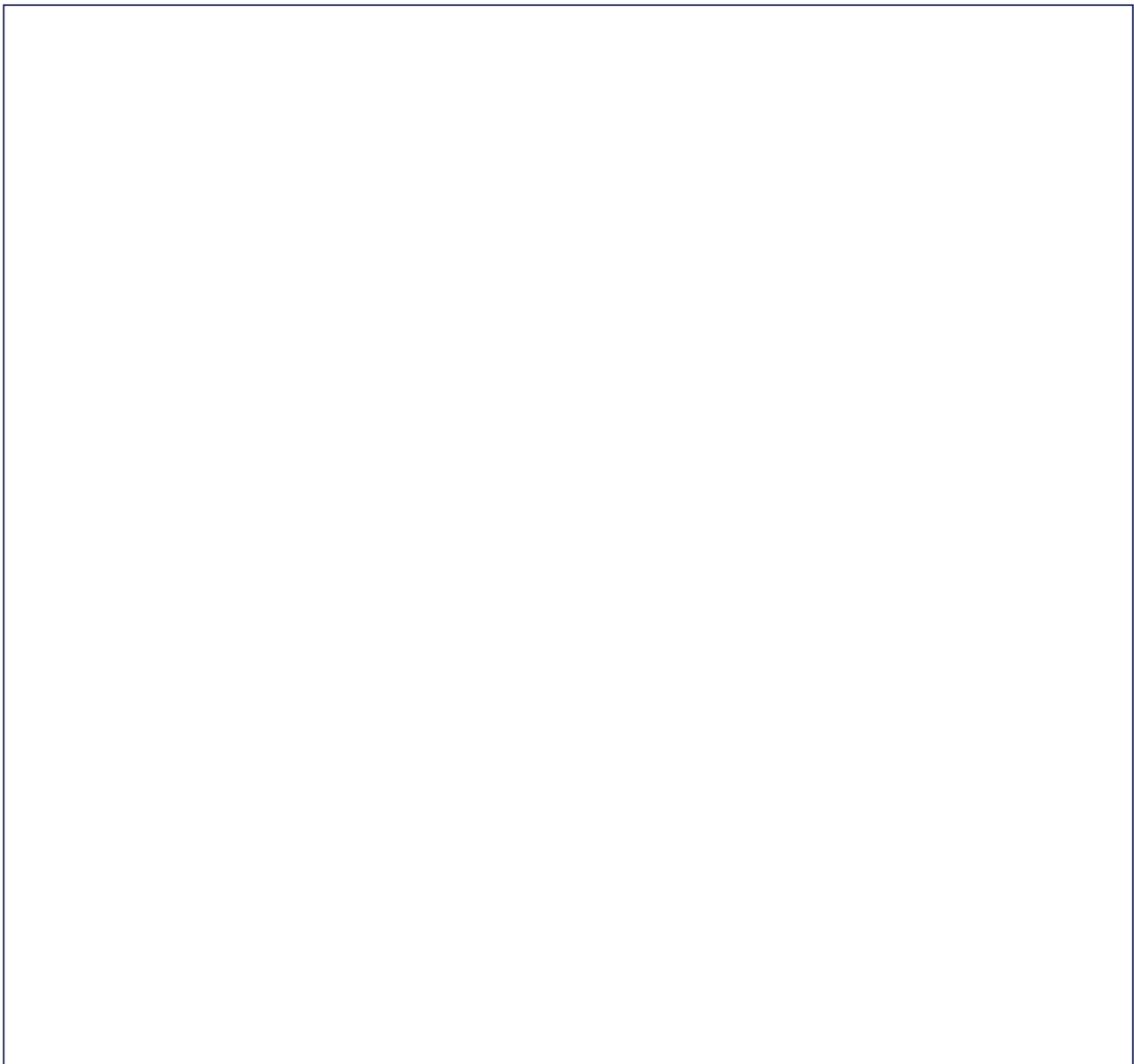


# Nova's Seasonal Garden

*Learning objective: To observe and describe weather associated with the four seasons.*

Look at the picture of Nova the owl's garden. Colour each section to show how the tree changes through the year. Read the facts about the seasons below.

**Colour this: A large, central oak tree divided into four vertical sections, one for each season. Section 1 (Spring): New green buds and small colourful flowers. Section 2 (Summer): Full, bright green leaves and a bright sun in the sky. Section 3 (Autumn): Orange and brown leaves falling to the ground. Section 4 (Winter): Bare branches with white, fluffy snow resting on them. Nova the owl is perched on a middle branch, wearing a small scarf. The background shows a simple horizon line.**



## Steps:

1. Label the season where the tree has white snow on its branches.
2. Label the season where the tree has new, green buds and flowers.
