

Nova's Seasonal Changes Flashcards

Learning objective: To identify and describe the four seasons and the changes associated with weather and daylight in the UK.

Read the front of the card to Nova, then flip it over to see if your answer matches the definition on the back. Use these to test your knowledge of how the seasons change!

Which season comes after Winter, when new flowers begin to bloom?	Which season is usually the warmest, with the longest hours of daylight?
Spring	Summer
In which season do leaves often change colour and fall from the trees?	Which season is the coldest, sometimes bringing frost or snow in the UK?
Autumn	Winter
What do we call the four different times of the year caused by the Earth's orbit?	Does the amount of daylight get longer or shorter as we move from Summer into Autumn?
Seasons	Shorter
What happens to the temperature as we move from Spring into Summer?	Which animal might go into hibernation during the cold Winter months?
It gets warmer	A hedgehog
True or False: We have the same amount of daylight every single day of the year.	What is the weather like during a typical Summer day in the UK?
False	Warm and sunny
What is the weather like during a typical Winter day in the UK?	Which season is known for being a time of new life, such as lambs being born?
Cold and often rainy or frosty	Spring
