What do we call the colourful flowers that grow on fruit trees in spring?	What happens to the amount of daylight during spring?
Blossom	The days get longer
What is the word for when birds travel long distances to return home for spring?	What is the small, hard lump on a branch that turns into a leaf or flower?
Migration	Bud
What do bees do to flowers that helps new seeds to grow?	What happens to the temperature in spring?
Pollination	It gets warmer
What do we call trees that lose their leaves in winter and grow new ones in spring?	What is the set of changes an animal goes through as it grows?
Deciduous trees	Life cycle
