

Springtime Science with Bea the Bee

Learning objective: To identify signs of spring and understand how plants and animals change as the weather gets warmer.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the answers. Write your answers in the boxes provided.

Bea the bee is busy! Spring is here. The days get longer and the sun is out more. Plants start to grow and flowers open. Animals wake up from their winter sleep. Everything is changing!
