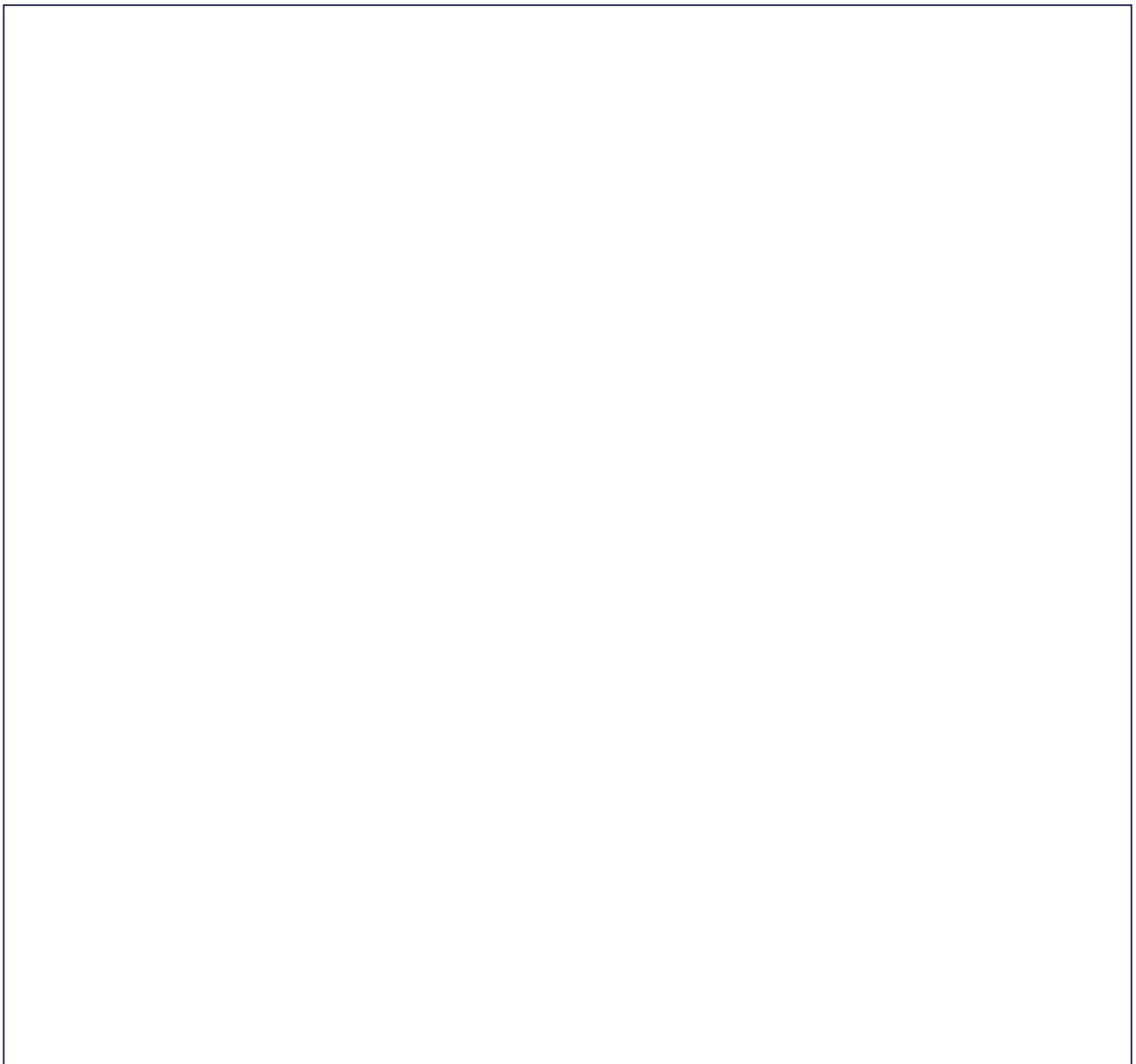


Zara's Abstract Art Adventure

Look at the patterns and shapes below. Zara the Zebra loves abstract art because it doesn't have to look like a real-life object! Use your brightest colouring pencils or crayons to fill in the spaces. You can use any colours you like to make the picture look happy, calm, or energetic.
