

Zara's Autumn Art Explorer

Learning objective: To observe seasonal changes in nature and express observations through creative language and drawing.

Join Zara the Zebra on an autumn adventure! Take a walk outside to look for signs of autumn. Use this template to record what you see, hear, and feel. Draw your favourite autumn treasure in the box and use the words in our bank to describe it.

Word bank: crunchy · gold · orange · brown · falling · crisp · bright · twigs

1. My Autumn Treasure: What did you find on your walk? Describe what it looks like using your own words. (2 marks)

2. The Colour Hunt: What colours can you see on the leaves today? Tell me about them. (2 marks)

3. Autumn Sounds: What sounds do you hear when you walk on leaves or listen to the wind? (2 marks)

4. Nature Pattern: Zara loves patterns! Can you describe a pattern you see on a leaf or a tree bark? (2 marks)

5. Autumn Feeling: How does the autumn air feel on your cheeks? Is it cold, crisp, or windy? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Collect three different shaped leaves and bring them back to the classroom. Can you sort them by size, colour, or shape with a friend?
