

Zara the Zebra's Easter Garden

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and explore seasonal patterns and traditions.

Use your favourite colouring pencils or crayons to bring Zara's garden to life. Look at the patterns on the eggs and try to use different colours for each shape!

Colour this: A friendly zebra named Zara standing in a grassy garden. Zara is holding a paintbrush and has a basket full of different sized eggs next to her. The eggs have various simple patterns on them: spots, stripes, and zig-zags. In the background, there are three large, open daffodils and a small butterfly flying above. The outlines should be clear and thick for easy colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the largest egg in the picture.
2. Label the flower that Zara is standing next to.
