- Spring is the season when many new flowers grow. We can look at the different shapes of petals to help us draw them.
- Zara loves to use patterns. Try drawing zig-zags, dots, or stripes on your Easter egg shapes to make them look unique.
- You can use bright colours like yellow, green, and pink to show that spring has arrived.
- Texture is how something feels. You can press a sponge into paint to make your Easter art look bumpy and exciting.
- Symmetry means both sides look the same. If you fold your paper in half after painting, you can make a matching pattern on the other side.

Did you know? Did you know that many artists use spring as their inspiration? When the flowers bloom, they see lots of lovely shapes and bright colours to use in their paintings!
