

Zara's Picasso-Inspired Art Studio

Learning objective: To explore the work of Pablo Picasso, focusing on abstract shapes, colours, and emotional expression through art.

Today, we are learning about a famous artist named Pablo Picasso. He liked to paint people and things using bright colours and interesting shapes. Use this template to record your own art project. Look at Zara the Zebra's patterns, then create your own 'Picasso-style' portrait. Use the boxes below to describe your work and explain the colours you chose.

1. My Art Title: Give your masterpiece a special name. What is your picture about?

2. Shapes and Lines: What shapes can you see in your art? Did you use circles, triangles, or squares?

3. My Colour Choices: Why did you choose these colours? How do they make you feel?

4. The Face: Picasso often moved eyes and noses to different places. Where did you put the eyes in your portrait?

5. Artist Reflection: What was your favourite part of making this picture today?

Extension challenge: Find a partner and look at their art. Can you find three different shapes in their picture and name the colours they used?
