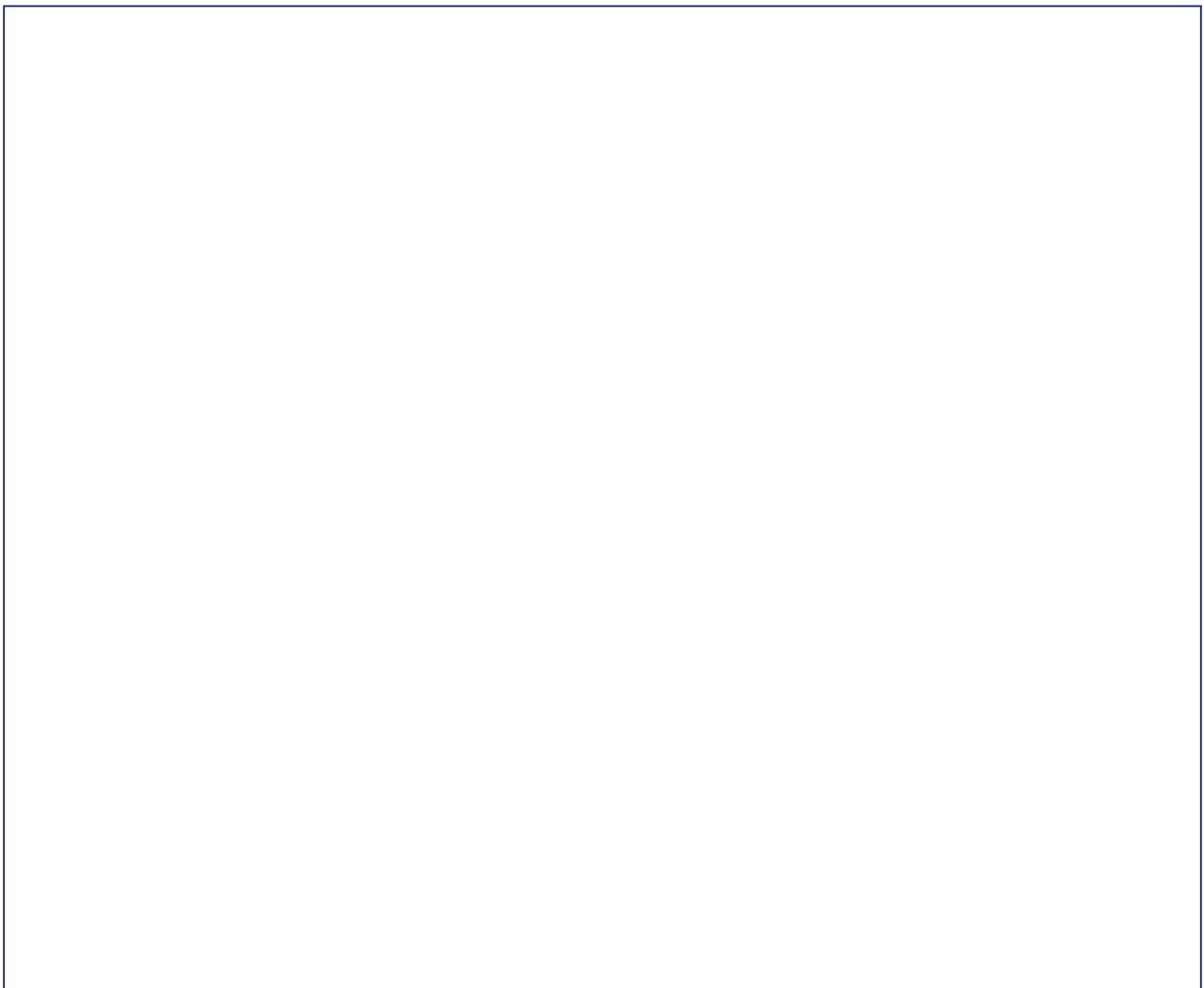


Pip's World Book Day Adventure

Learning objective: To express ideas and feelings through drawing and to develop fine motor skills by adding labels to an illustration.

Today we are celebrating World Book Day! Look at the scene below. Pip the bookworm needs your help to finish the picture. Follow the steps to add your own creative details, then use the word bank to label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Pip the caterpillar sitting on a large, green leaf in a magical forest. In front of Pip, draw a large, open book. From the pages of the book, draw a 'story cloud' where the child can draw their own favourite character. The style should be bright, friendly, and inviting, using simple shapes that are easy for EYFS children to replicate with crayons or felt-tip pens.



Label words: book · caterpillar · stars · tree · colourful

Steps:

1. Step 1: Pip is sitting on a leaf. Draw a big, open book in front of Pip for him to read.
2. Step 2: Draw your favourite storybook character appearing from the pages of Pip's book.
3. Step 3: Add some colourful patterns around the edge of your page to show how much you love stories.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank provided.

5. Step 5: Tell a friend or teacher one reason why you chose that character to draw.
