

# Kit's Secret Code Keeper

*Learning objective: To understand how to create strong, secure passwords to keep personal information safe online.*

Kit the Fox is helping his friends set up their computer accounts. A strong password is like a secret key. Help Kit sort the passwords into 'Strong' (hard to guess) or 'Weak' (easy to guess). Write 'Strong' or 'Weak' next to each password, then explain why.

*Word bank: Password · Personal · Secure · Guess · Characters*

**1. 1. Password: '123456' - Is this Strong or Weak? Why? (2 marks)**

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**2. 2. Password: 'BlueDog7!' - Is this Strong or Weak? Why? (2 marks)**

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**3. 3. Password: 'MyName' - Is this Strong or Weak? Why? (2 marks)**

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**4. 4. Write your own strong password using a mix of letters, numbers, and symbols. (2 marks)**

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**Draw: Draw a shield around your strong password to show that it is protected and safe from hackers.**



*Extension challenge: Think of a secret sentence to help you remember your new strong password. For example, 'I have 2 very fast red cars!' could become 'lh2vfrc!'.*
