

Character Creator: The Adjective Adventure

Learning objective: To use a wide range of adventurous and precise adjectives to describe a character's appearance and personality.

Join Leo the lion on an expedition to discover new characters! Use the sections below to build a unique character. Remember, for each section, use at least one 'shades of meaning' adjective—instead of just saying 'big', try 'enormous', 'colossal', or 'vast'.

Word bank: magnificent · shimmering · cunning · mysterious · clumsy · radiant · ancient · vibrant · dreadful · glistening · formidable · graceful

1. Physical Appearance: Describe what your character looks like. Think about their size, the texture of their skin or fur, and their most striking feature. (3 marks)

2. The Outfit: What is your character wearing? Describe the colours, patterns, and the condition of their clothes or armour. (3 marks)

3. Personality Traits: Choose two adjectives to describe your character's personality. Explain why they behave this way with an example. (4 marks)

4. The Hidden Secret: Every character has a secret. Describe their secret using an adjective that hints at whether it is dangerous, funny, or precious. (3 marks)

5. The Setting: Where does your character live? Describe their home using adjectives that appeal to the senses (e.g., smell, sound, sight). (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Now that you have described your character, write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) describing them meeting Leo the lion for the first time. Try to use at least three high-level adjectives to describe how they react to one another.
