1. Max is trying to solve a complex maths puzzle. Rewrite the sentence 'Max solved the puzzle' by adding two different adverbs to explain how he did it and how difficult he found it. (2 marks)

2. Identify the adverb in the following sentence and state what type of information it provides (e.g., time, place, manner, or degree): 'Pip the caterpillar read the book yesterday.' (2 marks)

3. Choose an adverb from the word bank to complete this sentence: 'Zara painted the sunset _____ because she wanted to capture the changing colours perfectly.' Explain why you chose that specific adverb. (3 marks)

4. Rewrite this sentence to include a fronted adverbial to indicate when the action is happening: 'Nova observed the constellations through her telescope.' (2 marks)

5. Compare and contrast the effect of the adverbs 'slowly' and 'sluggishly' in the sentence: 'The tortoise moved _____ across the garden.' Which word provides a more vivid image and why? (3 marks)

6. Justify your answer: In the sentence 'The diamond was extremely bright,' is 'extremely' an adverb? Explain your reasoning by identifying the word it modifies. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey solving a giant, floating maths equation in the air. Label your drawing with three adverbs that describe how he is moving or thinking (e.g., 'energetically', 'intently').

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph (4-6 sentences) describing a day in the life of Leo the Lion. Your writing must include at least one adverb of manner, one adverb of time, and one adverb of degree. Underline your adverbs and explain why your chosen vocabulary enhances the reader's understanding of Leo's character.
