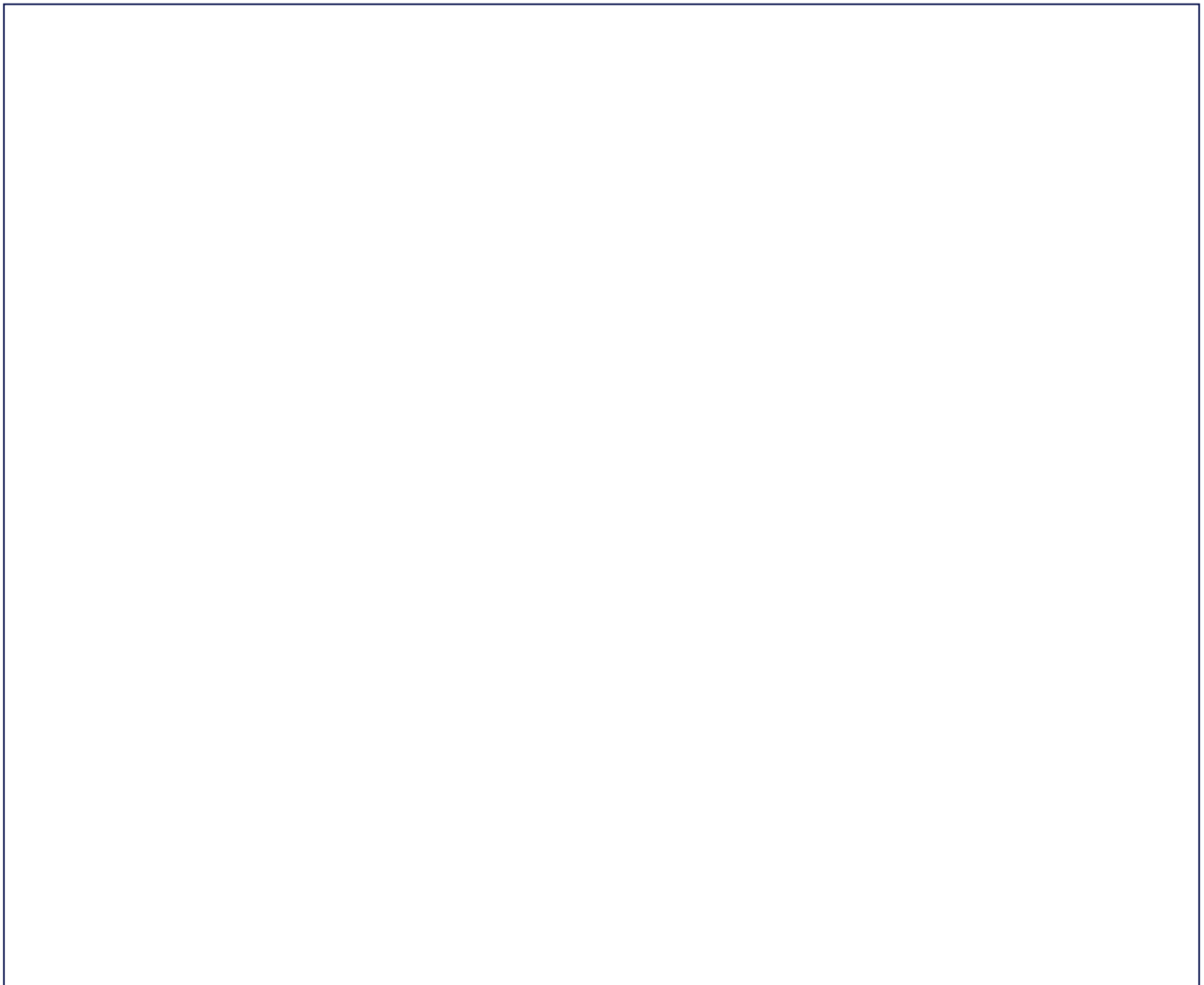


Easter Traditions and Symbols: A Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate symbols associated with the celebration of Easter and use descriptive language to label a creative scene.

Use your imagination to create a beautiful Easter scene. Follow the steps below to include key symbols, then use the word bank to label your drawing accurately.

Draw: Create a vibrant scene on a piece of A4 paper. Start by drawing a large, central egg decorated with intricate patterns like zig-zags, spots, or stripes. Place the egg inside a woven nest. Surround the nest with bright yellow daffodils and green grass. In the sky, draw a warm sun and perhaps a small, fluffy cloud. Use bright, cheerful colours to make the scene feel like a sunny spring morning.



Label words: spring flowers · decorated egg · new life · nest · daffodils · sunshine · ribbon

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, decorated egg in the centre of your page. What patterns will you use to make it colourful?
2. Step 2: Draw a nest around your egg and add some spring flowers blooming nearby. Which flowers did you choose to draw?
3. Step 3: Label at least four items from your drawing using the words provided in the word bank.

4. Step 4: Think about the theme of 'new life'. Draw one extra detail in the background to show that spring has arrived.
5. Step 5: Write one sentence at the bottom of your sheet to describe why you think these symbols represent Easter.
