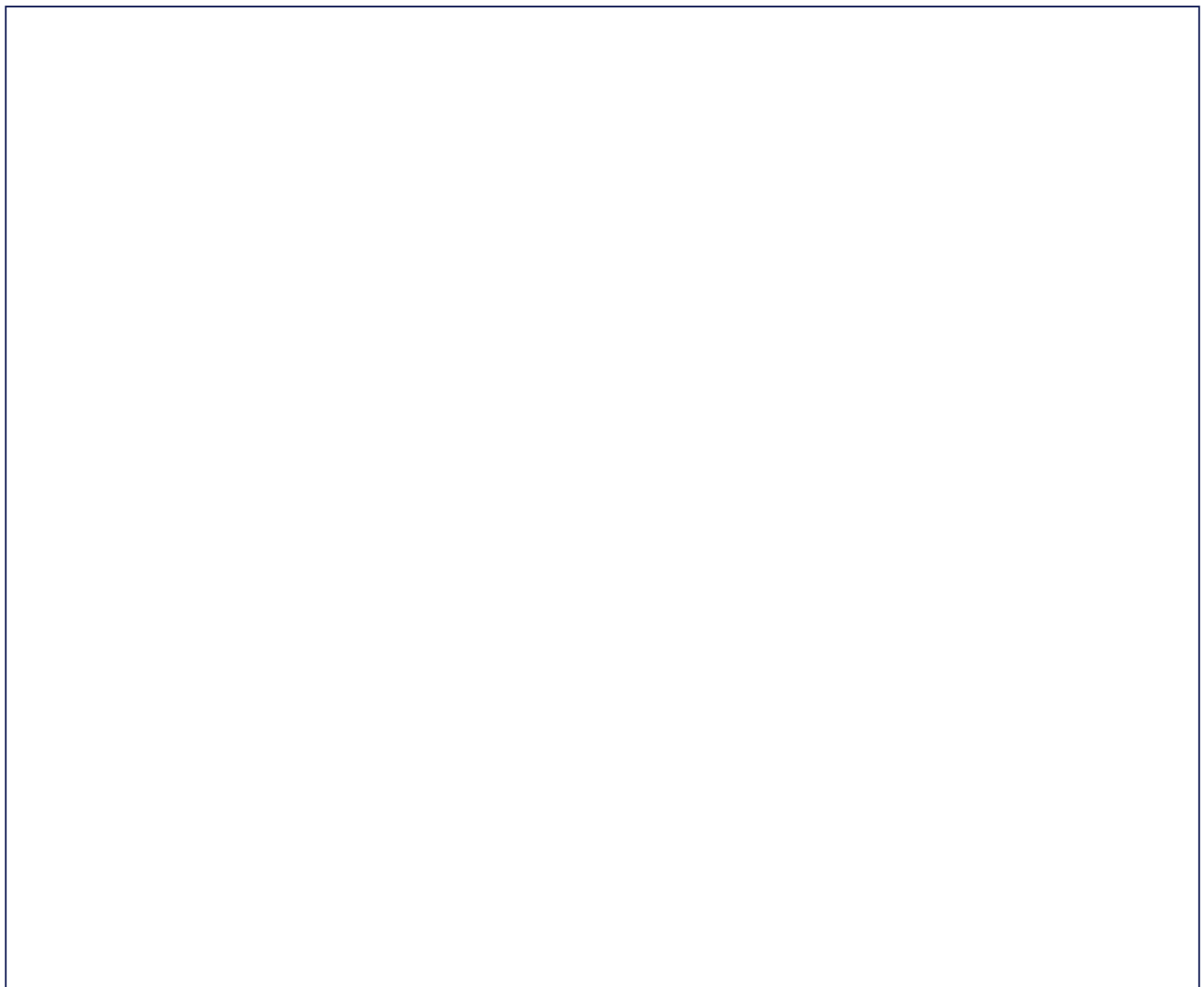


Figurative Language in the Forest: A Creative Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate examples of figurative language including metaphors, similes, and personification.

Use your imagination to bring these literary devices to life! Follow the drawing prompt below and then answer the questions to demonstrate your understanding of figurative language.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Max the monkey in the Enchanted Woods. Your drawing must include: 1. A 'giant coin' sun hanging in the sky. 2. Trees that look like they are leaning in to whisper. 3. A path that looks like a winding ribbon. Use a colourful, artistic style and label your illustration with the literary devices you have depicted.



Label words: Simile · Metaphor · Personification · Hyperbole · Alliteration · Onomatopoeia

Steps:

1. Identify the metaphor Max uses to describe the sun. Why is this a metaphor and not a simile?
2. Find the example of personification in the passage. Explain what human action the wind is performing.
3. Which phrase is an example of hyperbole? Why does Max use this exaggeration?
4. Write your own simile to describe how Max feels as he jumps from tree to tree.

5. Label your drawing with two examples of figurative language used in the scene.
