

Max and Pip's Noun and Verb Flashcards

Learning objective: To identify and distinguish between nouns and verbs within sentences.

Read the front of the card to identify if the word is a noun or a verb. Flip the card to check your answer. Max the monkey and Pip the caterpillar have provided examples to help you learn!

What is a noun?

A noun is a word that names a person, place, or thing.

What is a verb?

A verb is a word that describes an action, state, or occurrence.

Is 'Max' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is the name of a person/character).

Is 'jump' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is 'caterpillar' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing/living creature).

Is 'read' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

In the sentence 'Pip eats a leaf', which word is the noun?

Pip and leaf.

In the sentence 'Max climbs the tree', which word is the verb?

climbs.

Is 'park' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a place).

Is 'run' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is 'book' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing).

Is 'dance' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).
