

Animal Fact-File: A Report by [Your Name]

Learning objective: To write a non-chronological report about an animal using subheadings and technical vocabulary.

Today, you are going to be like Nova the owl! Use this template to write a fact-file about an animal of your choice. Remember to use a capital letter and a full stop for every sentence. Use your best handwriting and make sure your facts are accurate.

Word bank: habitat · diet · nocturnal · mammal · amphibian · predator · prey · features · fascinating

1. Introduction: Name the animal you have chosen and write one or two sentences explaining why they are special or interesting. (2 marks)

2. Appearance: Describe what your animal looks like. Think about its size, colour, and any special body parts like fur, feathers, or scales. (3 marks)

3. Habitat: Where does this animal live? Describe the environment, such as a forest, the ocean, or a desert. (2 marks)

4. Diet: What does this animal like to eat? Is it a carnivore, a herbivore, or an omnivore? (2 marks)

5. Amazing Fact: Write one surprising or 'brilliant' fact about your animal that your friends might not know. (2 marks)
