

My Character Profile with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To describe characters using adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

Leo the Lion wants to help you create a brand-new character for a story! Use this template to plan what your character looks like, how they behave, and what makes them special. Think carefully about your adjectives to make your descriptions come to life.

Word bank: courageous · mysterious · gentle · sparkling · enormous · fearsome · magical · adventurous · dazzling · timid

1. Character Name and Appearance: Who is your character and what do they look like? Use expanded noun phrases (e.g., the fluffy, golden-furred creature). (3 marks)

2. Personality Traits: What is your character like on the inside? Are they kind, grumpy, or very brave? (2 marks)

3. Special Skills: What is one thing your character is brilliant at doing? How do they use this skill? (2 marks)

4. Favourite Item: If your character could carry one thing with them everywhere, what would it be and why? (2 marks)

5. The Big Secret: Every great character has a secret. What is your character hiding from the rest of the world? (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph in your book describing your character arriving at a mysterious forest. Can you use at least two fronted adverbials, such as 'Suddenly,' or 'In the dark of the night,'?
