

World Book Day Adventure with Pip

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and adjectives to create a character profile for a storybook.

Pip the bookworm caterpillar is planning a story for World Book Day, but he needs help describing his new characters! Read the word bank of adjectives and nouns, then use them to build your character descriptions. Complete the sentences to bring your character to life.

Word bank: courageous · mysterious · glistening · enormous · gentle · sparkling · tattered · enchanted · adventure · gadget

1. Pip needs a hero. Write a sentence describing a hero using at least two adjectives from the word bank. (2 marks)

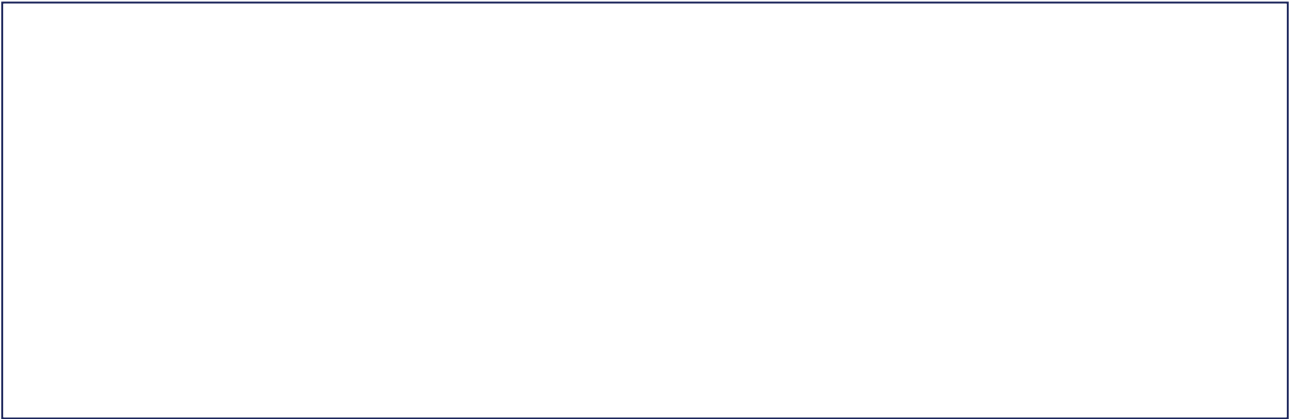
2. Describe the hero's special item (like a map or a tool). Use the word 'gadget' or 'adventure' in your sentence. (2 marks)

3. Choose a setting for your story. Write a sentence describing a place using the adjective 'enchanted' or 'glistening'. (2 marks)

4. What is one goal your hero wants to achieve on World Book Day? Write a full sentence. (2 marks)

5. Why is reading important to you? Write a short, persuasive sentence to encourage others to read. (2 marks)
