Learning objective: To write a clear and concise book review, expressing personal opinions and explaining preferences using descriptive language.

Celebrate World Book Day with Pip the bookworm! Think of your favourite book that you have read recently. Fill in the sections below to share why your chosen book is special. Use the word bank to help you describe the story and your thoughts.

1. Book Title and Author: Write the full name of the book and the person who wrote it. (2 marks)

2. The Plot: Briefly summarise what happens in the story without giving away the ending. (3 marks)

3. My Favourite Character: Who is your favourite character and why do you like them? (2 marks)

4. My Opinion: What did you enjoy most about this book? Was it the setting, the humour, or the excitement? (3 marks)

5. Recommendation: Who would you suggest this book to and why should they read it? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite scene from the book you have reviewed. Think about the setting and what the characters are doing.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are Pip the bookworm. Write a short sentence explaining which book you would choose to read on a rainy afternoon and why.
