

The World Book Day Character Quest

Learning objective: To analyse character traits and motivations by matching original literary descriptions to the BookFlik characters.

Read the descriptions of five different characters preparing for a World Book Day celebration. Match each description to the correct BookFlik character from the list provided. Explain your reasoning by identifying the specific clues in the text that helped you decide.

Word bank: Pip · Nova · Max · Ellie · Finn

1. Character A loves to observe the night sky and asks why the moon glows. She is preparing a costume inspired by a cosmic explorer. Which BookFlik character is this, and what is your reasoning? (2 marks)

2. Character B is creating a budget for his costume, calculating that his cape costs £4.50 and his hat costs £2.75. He loves solving numerical puzzles. Which BookFlik character is this? (2 marks)

3. Character C is organizing a library display and can remember every book title she has read since she was a calf. Which BookFlik character is this? (2 marks)

4. Character D is busy reading five different stories at once, using his many legs to turn the pages. He loves collecting new words for his vocabulary jar. Which BookFlik character is this? (2 marks)

5. Character E is plotting a route on an atlas to see where the best stories in the world originate. He loves maps and the deep blue sea. Which BookFlik character is this? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene where all five characters are sitting together in a cosy library corner. Show Pip reading a book, Nova looking at a star map, Max counting coins, Ellie reminiscing about a story, and Finn pointing to a globe.



Extension challenge: Write a short diary entry (50-80 words) from the perspective of one of these characters, describing why they are excited about World Book Day and which book they have chosen to celebrate.
