Learning objective: To write a creative book review that expresses personal preferences and justifies opinions using descriptive language.

Join Pip the bookworm and celebrate World Book Day by reflecting on a story you have recently enjoyed. Use the sections below to share your thoughts, describe the plot, and explain why you would recommend this book to a friend. Write in full, grammatically correct sentences.

1. Book Title and Author: Write the title of the book and the author's name. Briefly explain why you chose this particular book to review today. (2 marks)

2. Plot Summary: Provide a brief summary of the main events in the story. Remember to include the setting and the primary conflict, but try not to reveal the ending! (4 marks)

3. Character Spotlight: Choose one character from the story. Describe their personality and explain how they changed or grew throughout the narrative. (3 marks)

4. Personal Reflection: Which part of the book did you find the most exciting or moving? Explain your reasoning using evidence from the text. (3 marks)

5. Recommendation: Would you recommend this book to a classmate? If so, what kind of reader would enjoy it most and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are the author of this book. Write a short paragraph explaining the inspiration behind your story and what message you wanted the reader to take away.
