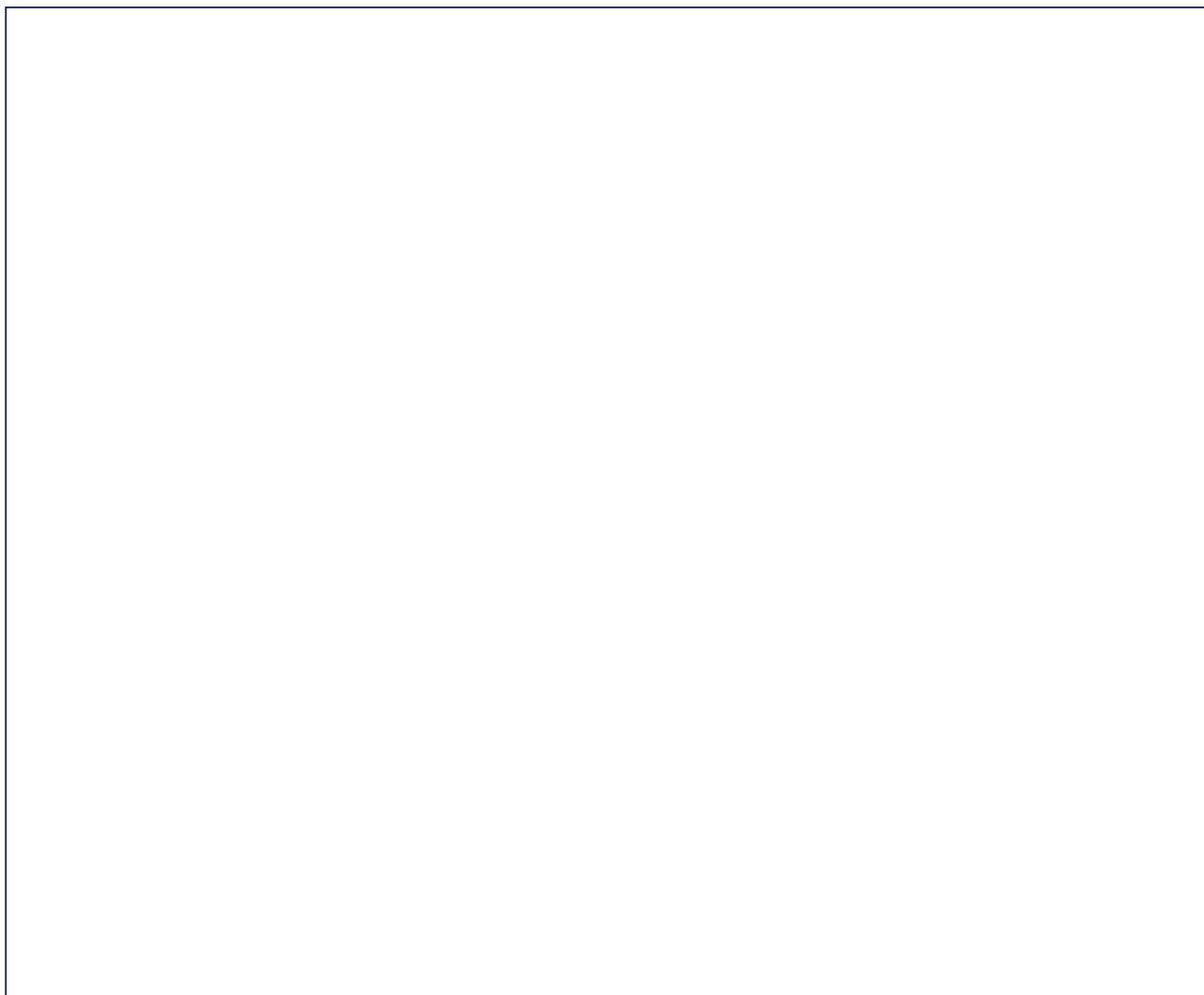


Rosa's Animal Artistry: French Vocabulary Challenge

Learning objective: To identify, translate, and label a variety of animals in French whilst applying descriptive adjectives.

Follow Rosa the parrot's instructions to create a vibrant scene. First, draw the animals listed below in their natural habitats. Once your scene is complete, label each animal using the correct French noun from the word bank. Finally, add one French adjective to describe each animal (e.g., 'le chien grand').

Draw: Create a split-landscape scene. On the left side, draw a sunny meadow containing a horse, a rabbit, and a dog. On the right side, draw a pond or garden area containing a bird, a fish, a mouse, a cat, and a snake. Use a detailed, illustrative style. Ensure every animal is clearly identifiable so that you can add your French labels next to them.



Label words: le chien (dog) · le chat (cat) · l'oiseau (bird) · le lapin (rabbit) · le poisson (fish) · la souris (mouse) · le cheval (horse) · le serpent (snake)

Steps:

1. Identify three animals from your drawing that are mammals. Explain why they are classified as mammals in French.
2. If you were to add an adjective to 'le lapin', which word would you choose? Justify your choice based on its appearance in your drawing.

3. Compare and contrast the French words 'le poisson' and 'l'oiseau'. How do their habitats differ in your drawing?
4. What might happen if you swapped the environments of 'le serpent' and 'le poisson'? Explain the impact on their survival.
5. Label your drawing with the correct French nouns from the word bank, ensuring you include the correct definite article (le, la, or l').
6. Rosa wants to introduce a new animal. Choose an animal not in the word bank, write its name in French, and draw it in your scene.
