

Rosa the Parrot's Body Part Labelling Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and write the names of body parts in French.

Rosa the parrot has drawn a picture of herself, but she has forgotten the French labels! Look at the arrows pointing to her body. Choose the correct French word from the word bank and write it on the line next to each number. Use the pictures to help you identify which part is which.

Word bank: la tête (head) · le bras (arm) · la main (hand) · la jambe (leg) · le pied (foot)

1. 1. Look at the arrow pointing to the top of Rosa's head. Write the French word here: (1 mark)

2. 2. Look at the arrow pointing to her wing/arm area. Write the French word here: (1 mark)

3. 3. Look at the arrow pointing to her wing-tip/hand area. Write the French word here: (1 mark)

4. 4. Look at the arrow pointing to her long leg. Write the French word here: (1 mark)

5. 5. Look at the arrow pointing to her foot. Write the French word here: (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot. Add five arrows pointing to her head, arm, hand, leg, and foot. Label each arrow with the correct French word from your word bank.



Extension challenge: Can you say the French words out loud to a partner? Try to point to your own head, arm, hand, leg, and foot while you say the words!
