

French Body Parts Assessment

Learning objective: To identify and name parts of the body in French.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. I am here to help you with your French. Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you get stuck. You can do it!

Rosa the parrot is looking at a picture of a friend. She points to different parts of the body to practise her French words.

Word bank: la tête (head) · les yeux (eyes) · le nez (nose) · la bouche (mouth) · les oreilles (ears) · le bras (arm) · la main (hand) · la jambe (leg) · le pied (foot)

1. Write the French word for 'the head'. (2 marks)

2. Match these body parts to their French names: 1) Hand = _____, 2) Leg = _____. (4 marks)

3. Rosa has two eyes. Write 'the eyes' in French. (2 marks)

4. Fill in the blanks: My face has a nose (le _____) and a mouth (la _____). (4 marks)

5. Rosa is describing a monster. She says: 'Il a une grande tête et deux petits pieds.' (He has a big head and two small feet.) Draw what she describes and label the head and feet in French. (8 marks)

6. Write 5 short sentences using the words from the word bank. Example: 'J'ai une main.' (I have a hand.) (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a funny monster and label its head (la tête) and its feet (les pieds).
